Arena Drop-In Rules

- Drop-ins can occur any time there is open ice and runs on a first come first served basis
- There are **two tasks** that all drop-in participants must complete before they are allowed on the ice:
 - o Sign in using the drop-in ice rental waiver located in the binder
 - o Pay
- The rate for drop-in is \$10.00 for residents of the township and \$15.00 for non-residents
 - ID is required to confirm residency if ID is not presented, the non-resident fee is charged
 - o Participants must pay with exact change OR with debit. There will **not** be a float at the front desk to provide change
- Drop-in participants are only allowed to be on the ice for one hour (50 minutes if there is a rental coming up)
- Drop-in time slots cannot be reserved ahead of time
- Hockey players and figure skaters cannot be on the ice together during drop-ins. The group that arrives first will have first dibs on the ice
- Drop-in participants do not have a say in who can and cannot use the ice
- Floods are not required to be done before or in between drop-in time slots



Arena Drop-In Rules:

- Drop-in fee is \$10.00 each for residents, \$15.00 each for non-residents
 - o Staff may ask you for identification to prove your address at the door
- Fee can be paid by cash or debit
 - o PLEASE NOTE there is no float at the desk to make change
- You may use the ice for a full hour unless there is an upcoming rental
- Drop-in time slots cannot be reserved ahead of time
- Helmets must be worn by all participants if you are playing hockey
